With the help of members of the Ogemaw Arenac Amateur Radio Society, Scouts were able to use amateur radio equipment to talk with other Scouts and radio operators around the country. Contacts this year ranged from New York, South Carolina, and Washington State. In previous years, local Scouts were able to talk to Scouts and radio operators as far away as Italy and Luxembourg. 



Something most people have forgotten about is the NOAA weather radio system. It is a 24-hour FM Weather radio system design in the VHF bands on seven stations across the United States. The stations will broadcast a three to eight minute program with local observations and weather forecasts from the National Weather Service in that area. In the event of weather advisories/warning/watches are issues they will interrupt the broadcast to relay this information. Most if not all of our 2m, radios can tune into these stations.
